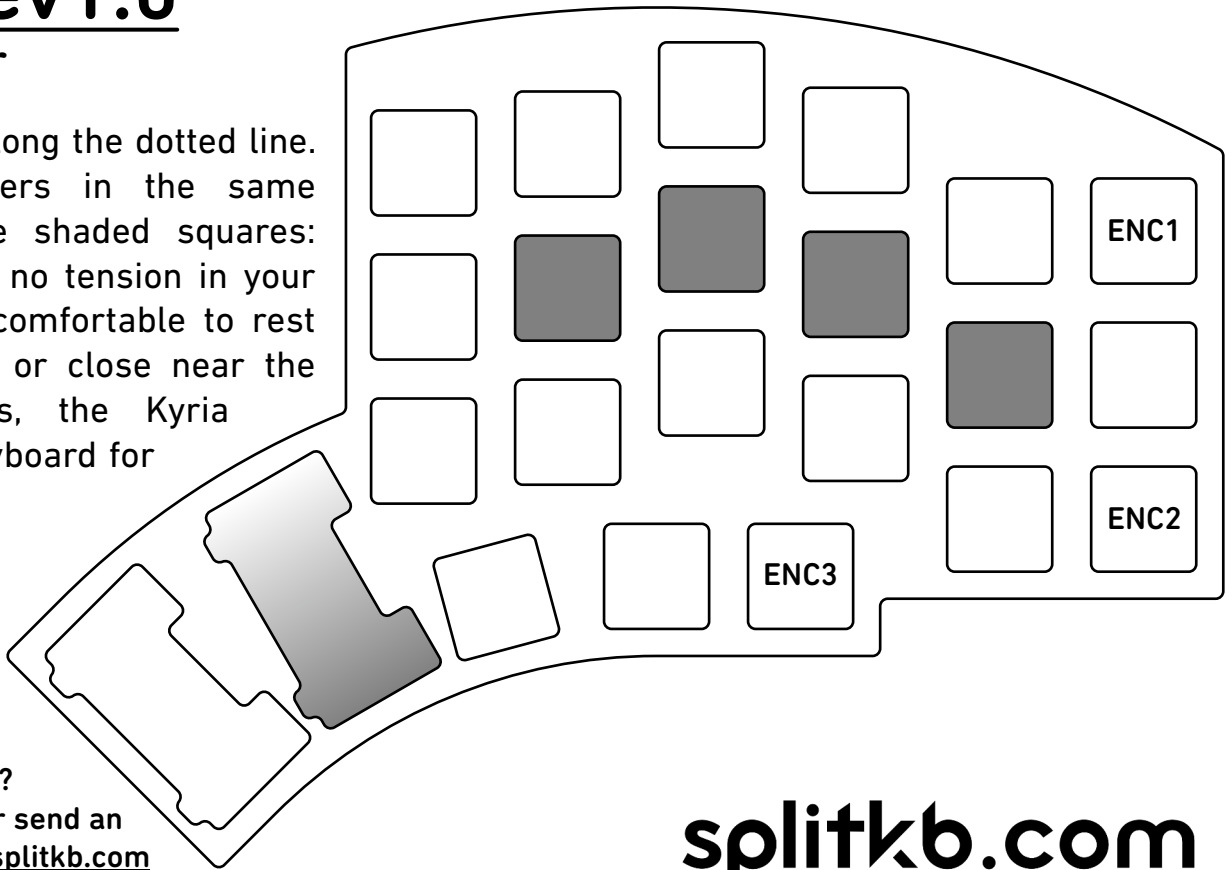


# Kyria rev1.0

## Layout tester

Cut this paper along the dotted line. Rest your fingers in the same columns as the shaded squares: there should be no tension in your fingers. If it is comfortable to rest your fingers on or close near the shaded squares, the Kyria might be the keyboard for you!

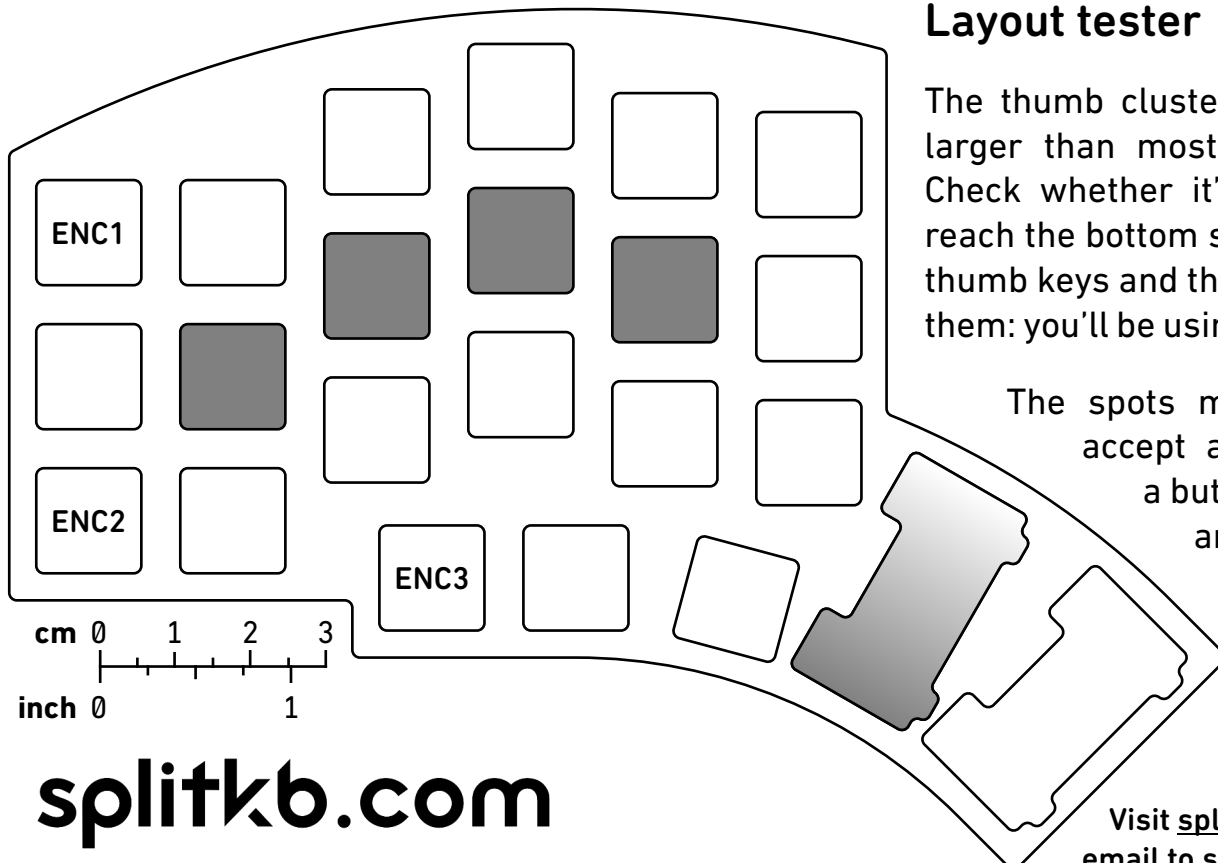


# Kyria rev1.0

## Layout tester

The thumb cluster on the Kyria is larger than most thumb clusters. Check whether it's comfortable to reach the bottom side of the shaded thumb keys and the two keys beside them: you'll be using these the most.

The spots marked with ENC accept a rotary encoder: a button you can press and turn. You can pick up to one spot per half.
